Presentations

The scheduled times of the oral presentations include discussion time, the speakers are kindly asked to arrange their contribution accordingly. The poster session will take place on Tuesday afternoon in the Aula of the Academy Main Building. The size of the posters to be presented is 841 mm x 1189 mm (ISO A0 format). Fastening material will be provided on site.

Proceedings

The proceedings of the conference will be published in “Hyperfine Interactions”. The authors will receive detailed information in due course. The deadline for manuscripts is **October 31st**, 2011. All conference contributions are entitled to submit an article.
